Winter Grooming Reminders

Sweaters and harnesses can cause hidden matting. Remove them daily to check chest, armpits, behind the legs, neck, and behind the ears.
Properly brushing these areas prevents matting.



Keeping coats longer for winter still requires routine grooming. Weather changes can cause impacted undercoat that home baths can't remove. Regular professional grooming helps de-shed, rebalance the coat, and keep skin moisturized.

Paw Pad Care



- Wipe paws to remove salt, ice, and debris
- Keep fur between pads trimmed
- Check regularly for dryness and cracking
- Apply paw balm as needed
